1 - What has your experience and engagement with the Bible been like over time? Where do you stand with the Bible today?

2 - When you read about the Bible being the perfect Word of God, what emotions rose up in you? Are there any doubts, fears, or skepticisms that come to mind? Why or why not?

3 - What are your thoughts on the process of canonization and how books were chosen to be included in the Bible? How does it impact your view of the Bible's reliability?

4 - The transmission of the Bible involves the accuracy of biblical texts over time. How do you feel knowing that we don't have the original manuscripts but have an enormous amount of other reference points? Does this affect your trust in the Bible's content? Why or why not?

5 - Different translations of the Bible are often created to try to reach a specific audience or for a specific purpose. How did this learning impact your previous understanding of different Bible translations? Discuss what the right Bible translation may be for you given what you know now.

6 - In general, what skepticisms were answered for you in this chapter? What learning was most encouraging or clarifying? What learning was the most challenging?
