1 - Share your journey from being a skeptic of the Bible to where you are now. If you're still skeptical, it's ok - your story is valuable to share, too. After sharing, discuss how the unique circumstances of your story could come alongside someone who's skeptical about the Bible.

2 - This week you worked through Mark 12:30 using an inductive Bible study known as the COMA Method. Share your answers for each step of this method with your group to affirm, clarify, or correct your answers and what the passage means for you today.

3 - This chapter argues the Bible has the ability to transform your life. If you have one, share a passage that has deeply impacted you and/or your love for God.

4 - How has community impacted your growth and study of the Bible? Share the value of these relationships with your group and consider reaching out to the people who have uniquely impacted you and thanking them.

5 - After working through various devotionals you could begin to apply in your life, what's your next step to create a realistic rhythm for yourself? Remember, these look different for each of us.

6 - In general, what skepticisms were answered for you in this chapter? What learning was most encouraging or clarifying? What learning was the most challenging?
